Greetings to all our Elders, Community Members and Relatives,

I would like send my condolences to the family members that has lost loved ones. The community will be in mourning for the funerals this week in White Shield with the families.

I would also like to say a Happy Belated Mother's Day to all the mothers. The Mother's are the backbone and caretakers of the family. I hope all the Mother's had enjoyed their special day and make sure you thank and tell your mom you love them.

We had a busy week with Graduations and Memorial Day activities in White Shield. The White Shield Graduation had

a excellent turnout. We had 7 graduates this year and 23 8th grade graduates. The Senior Class had asked me to do the Commencement Address for the Graduation Ceremonies and I did so to the best of my ability to make a successful address to the Seniors and graduating 8th grade students.

The Memorial Day Program at the Complex had another great turnout, the Ladies Auxiliary served some of the best food and they did the swearing in of officers. The guest speaker was American Legion Department Commander-Elect, Clarence L. Carroll III. Then at 5pm, the

Old Scouts Society held their annually Old Scouts Pow Wow held at the new Community Center. They had 17 drums and over 50 dancers. They had dance contests for all categories and every dancer was paid and drum split for all the drums. So they had a excellent turn out.

The Tribal Business Council recently approved the 2019 Tribal Audit and will be approving the 2020 Tribal Audit end of August. We are on track to have 2021 completed by end of the year. Currently the MHA Nation has a \$60 million operating budget and we have \$860 million in the People's Fund, and \$50 million in the Education Fund. Both funds currently grows every year at a rate of 6-7%, but every year the TBC has been putting into the Fund to continually grow.

Each College Student is eligible to receive up to \$18,000 per year for College Tuition and Fees. This is not including Higher Education Grant and/or Federal Pell Grant. So this is given to every Enrolled Tribal Member.

Small businesses are the cornerstone of many cities across the country.

More than 33 million businesses in the U.S. are considered “small,” according to the U.S. Chamber of Commerce.

Your News Leader headed to White Shield to find out how a newly opened small business will impact the community.

This is the start of something new at Tskaakit Lodge, meaning “coffee lodge,” inside the Arikara Fitness Center.

Shannon Usestheknife calls herself a regular and gave the drinks a 10 out of 10.

“I need it to survive,” said Usestheknife.

Fred Everett, CEO of Saunders Development Authority, said the idea came about a year and a half ago. He said MHA Chairman Mark Fox and Councilman Fred Fox played a big role in supporting their launch.

“We thought parents could come and watch their kids swim while they’re having a cup of coffee,” said Everett.

While the cafe held its grand opening Tuesday, many visitors to the Ralph



Wells Community Center have already had a taste of their coffee.

Manager Pam Nicholson said they allowed free taste tests five weeks prior to the official opening.

“I believe everybody enjoyed that and it helped us to set the actual flavors. We have specialized Red Bull zingers,” said Nicholson.

Usestheknife said she likes having more options for places to eat in the area. She said one of her favorites is the turkey provolone.

“It’s convenient to have fresh food,” said Usestheknife.

Everette said when a business is very new, it can be a little frightening.

“We want it to be successful and I’m judging my success a little differently than other people,” said Everette.

He said he’s invested in training the newcomers, even if they don’t have much experience in the working world.

Recipe Corner

Layered Taco Dip

This healthy recipe comes from NDSU Extension.

INGREDIENTS

- 8 ounces fat-free cream cheese
- 8 ounces plain Greek yogurt
- 16 ounces jar salsa
- ½ package Taco seasoning (1.5 tablespoons)
- 2 cups lettuce, shredded
- 2 roma tomatoes, diced
- ½ cup red onion, diced
- 1 bell pepper, diced
- ¾ cup black beans, drained and rinsed
- ½ cup cheddar cheese, shredded

DIRECTIONS

In a large bowl combine cream cheese, yogurt, salsa and taco seasoning. Mix well with an electric mixer. Spread on the bottom of a 9x13 inch shallow glass dish. Top with shredded lettuce, tomatoes, onion, pepper, black beans, and shredded cheese.

Serve with whole grain or baked tortilla chips.

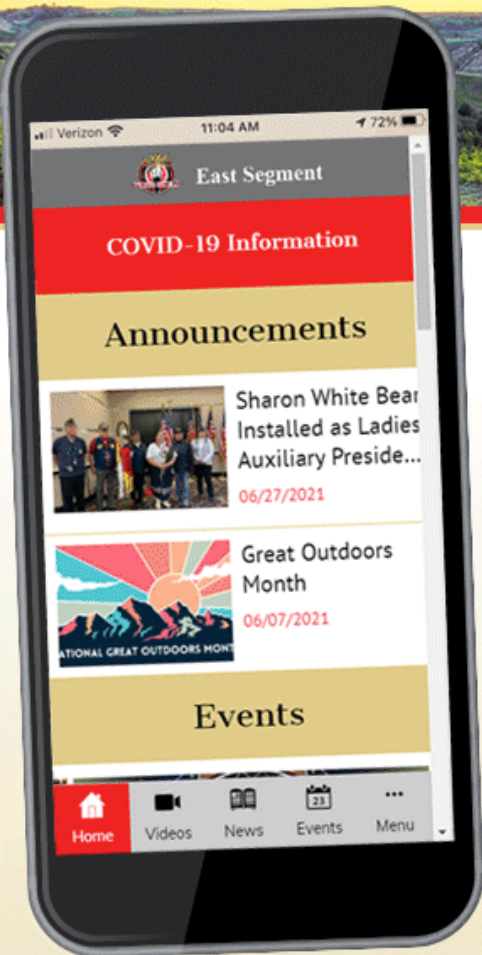
